
We practice the Horizontal Learning Process in real field

Missions


- ► To establish a non-governmental fund of rural women legally and formally

- Providing the ground for the participation of rural women in higher levels of management and decision-making
- Providing access to loans from other financial resources such as banks, institutions and ..
- Creating a platform to get more support from social and economic organizations of the province and city such as Local Government including governor of province, governorships of the city, etc.

Activity 2: Marketing

- Providing
 - Supporting the members to participate in national and international events and exhibitions
 - ► A place to sell and show the products
 - Providing working capital
 - Providing soft loan
 - ► Fixed capital: from the government, Micro credit Funds and Women Fund
- ▶ Direct employment: 5 rural women
- ► Indirect employment: 50 Fund women members

Activity 7: Monitoring the loan usage by members

- ▶ One of the programs of the fund after paying the loans to the members is to monitor the consumption of them. Since the establishment of the fund, various visits have been made to the activities of the shareholders.
- ▶ Also, the officials of the Ministry of Agriculture-Jahad and other organizations at the national and provincial levels have made several visits, which has increased the effectiveness of executive plans in women's Micro Credit Funds.


