Achievement of HLP Foundation

Successfully organized the International HLP Convention from 12–14

September 2023.



- Developed a web-based application, BMET (Budget Monitoring & Expenditure Tracking), to support Union Parishad budgeting (link: r2g.hlpfoundation.net).
- Successfully incorporated a dedicated nutrition budget line into the Union Parishad budget for the first time.
- Workshop on review of the BMET with NILG.

Achievement of HLP Foundation

- Increased the budget allocation for WASH and Nutrition from 1.45% to 18% in the 2024–25 fiscal year, with expenditure rising from 72% in 2022–23 to 89% in 2023–24.
